## JUNIOR


You will be going to a horse show. What discipline do you ride? What clothes would you need to bring, what tack or accessories do you need for yourself. Be creative!

## WALK/TROT


You will be writing a book report for school. Your topic you choose will be horses, of course! What will you write about? Give us the topic of your report and what details will you include?

## LEADLINE


Who is your favorite horse at your barn or anywhere? Tell us why and provide pictures of the horse if you can!



Enter ring at A at a walk. Turn to the right to perform a diagonal line to B showing at a trot on the correct diagonal. Halt. Turn to the left to perform a canter to C on the correct lead. Halt. Turn to the left to perform the canter on the incorrect lead to D. Halt. Turn to the left and drop your stirrups and trot back to A on the correct diagonal. Halt. Pick up your stirrups then back your horse 4 steps. You have completed your pattern!



Enter the ring at A at the walk. Turn to your right and trot a 3 loop serpentine to B showing the correct changes of diagonal. Halt at B. Pick up the canter and canter a circle in the center of the ring and continue down the rail to your left to C and halt at C. Drop your stirrups and trot to D on the correct diagonal. Halt and pick up your stirrups. You have completed your pattern!



Enter the ring at A at the walk. Pick up the trot and trot a diagonal line to B on the correct diagonal. Halt. Walk to C. Pick up the trot at C and trot down the rail to D showing a change of diagonal halfway down the rail. Halt. You have completed your pattern!
